PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The trapping of fur bearing animals and the trading of this fur has been a profession dating far back to the early fur traders and voyageurs, who made history in Minnesota and the nation, and,

WHEREAS, The trappers of Minnesota in order to continue this tradition, which today is more of a hobby and recreational factor, have formed the Minnesota Trappers Association, and,

WHEREAS, The National Trappers Association have seen fit to honor the State of Minnesota this year by having their National Convention held in Minnesota at Itasca State Park on September 27, 28, and 29th, and,

WHEREAS, There will be a large number of outdoor men who trap for sport and for profit attending this convention from all parts of the nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 28th day of September 1963, as,

"MINNESOTA TRAPPERS DAY"

and that a copy of this proclamation be forwarded to the Chairman of the Convention at Itasca State Park to be read to the delegates in attendance.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventeenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
