PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, 1963 is the 62d Anniversary of the Army Nurse Corps - a vital component in the defense of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, Within the Army, the Army Nurse Corps carries out its mission of assisting to maintain and conserve the strength of the Army through the special skills of its members; and

WHEREAS, Our fine Army Nurses display a high degree of professionalism. Indeed the Army Nurse Corps - with its dignity, discipline and duty performed has proved indispensable to our nation's Army both in peacetime and times of national emergency; and

WHEREAS, Presently, a shortage of nurses within the Army exists, which has led to a call for qualified volunteers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 23 to 30, 1963, as

"ARMY NURSE CORPS RECRUITING WEEK"

and I urge citizens throughout the great State of Minnesota to support the Army Nurse Corps and its aims and traditions.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
