PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS,

It has been called to my attention that Friday, June 28, 1963, marks the relinquishment of command of the United States Naval Reserve Volunteer Composite Company 9-41 by Captain Leas G. Schneickert, and,

WHEREAS,

Captain Schneickert was instrumental in establishing this company and, under his leadership, it received the Comendant's Trophy as the outstanding Naval Reserve group of its kind in the entire Ninth Naval District, and,

WHEREAS,

his retirement will occasion a Change of Command Ceremony and a special honors banquet and military ball to commemorate his fifteen years service to this unit, the people of Minnesota, and the United States, and,

WHEREAS,

These honors reflect the esteem and affection with which men devoted to the naval service and the defense of America hold for Captain Schneickert, and,

WHEREAS,

it is the custom and the duty of the State also to honor those who have unselfishly given their time and energies to the protection of our freedoms and the betterment of our State and Nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvady, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, June 28, 1963, as

and I urge all citizens to join with me in honoring this truly outstanding citizen of Minnesota and representative of the United States Naval Service.
