PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The United States Lawn Tennis Association has designated the week of July 7-13 as "National Play Tennis Week," a period when all Americans will be invited to turn to tennis as a sport which develops physical fitness, mental alertness, and sportsmanship, and

WHEREAS, by encouraging greater participation in the sport, it will aid the campaign to improve the physical fitness of our citizens, and

WHEREAS, it will provide an appropriate occasion for communities and clubs to undertake the training and competitive programs for youth which are necessary if the United States is to keep pace with other nations in maintaining amateur tennis.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 7-13 as,

PLAY TENNIS WEEK

and invite the attention of all our citizens to this observance, and to the beneficial aspects of tennis as a lifelong sport.
