NOTICE.

WHEREAS, a petition for the incorporation of the Village of Elrosa in Stearns County, Minnesota, a true copy of which petition is hereto annexed, has been duly filed with, approved and granted by the Board of County Commissioners of Stearns County, Minnesota.

Now therefore as provided by law, It Is Hereby Ordered, that an election be held of the voters of the territory described in said annexed petition for the purpose of voting upon the proposition of, whether or not, said voters are desirous of incorporating and do want to incorporate said territory as a village;

And it further ordered, that notice of said election be given by the posting of three copies of this notice with a copy of said petition annexed thereto, in three public places within the boundaries of said proposed village, which said notices shall be posted in said territory not less than twenty days prior to the date of holding of said elections as said dates is fixed herein, that there being no legal newspaper published within the limits of said proposed village, no further notice of the holding of said election need be given.

It is further ordered, that notice is hereby given that B. Osendorf, Daniel Stang and Henry Verkennis, residents of the territory herein sought to be incorporated as a Village be; and they are, hereby appointed as Judges and Inspectors of said election, and are hereby directed to conduct the same in accordance with the law and to make report of their proceedings and of the result of said election as required by law.

We, the undersigned petitioners, being more than twenty-five electors now residents upon the land to be incorporated as hereinafter set forth, respectfully represent that the land is not, nor any part thereof, in any incorporated village in the State of Minnesota; that a portion of same, to wit: The Townsite of Elrosa has been platted ~~xxxxxx~~ into lots and blocks, which plat has been duly and regularly certified to and is on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said Stearns County; that the remainder of said land is adjacent to the portion so platted.

That the number of persons actually residing in said territory so to be incorporated as hereinafter described is two hundred and eight (208), which has been duly ascertained under the direction of your said petitioners by a census taken of the resident population of said territory on the 18 day of July, A.D. 1916, and which said census is presented herewith; that the boundaries of said territory with their courses and directions are as follows, to wit:

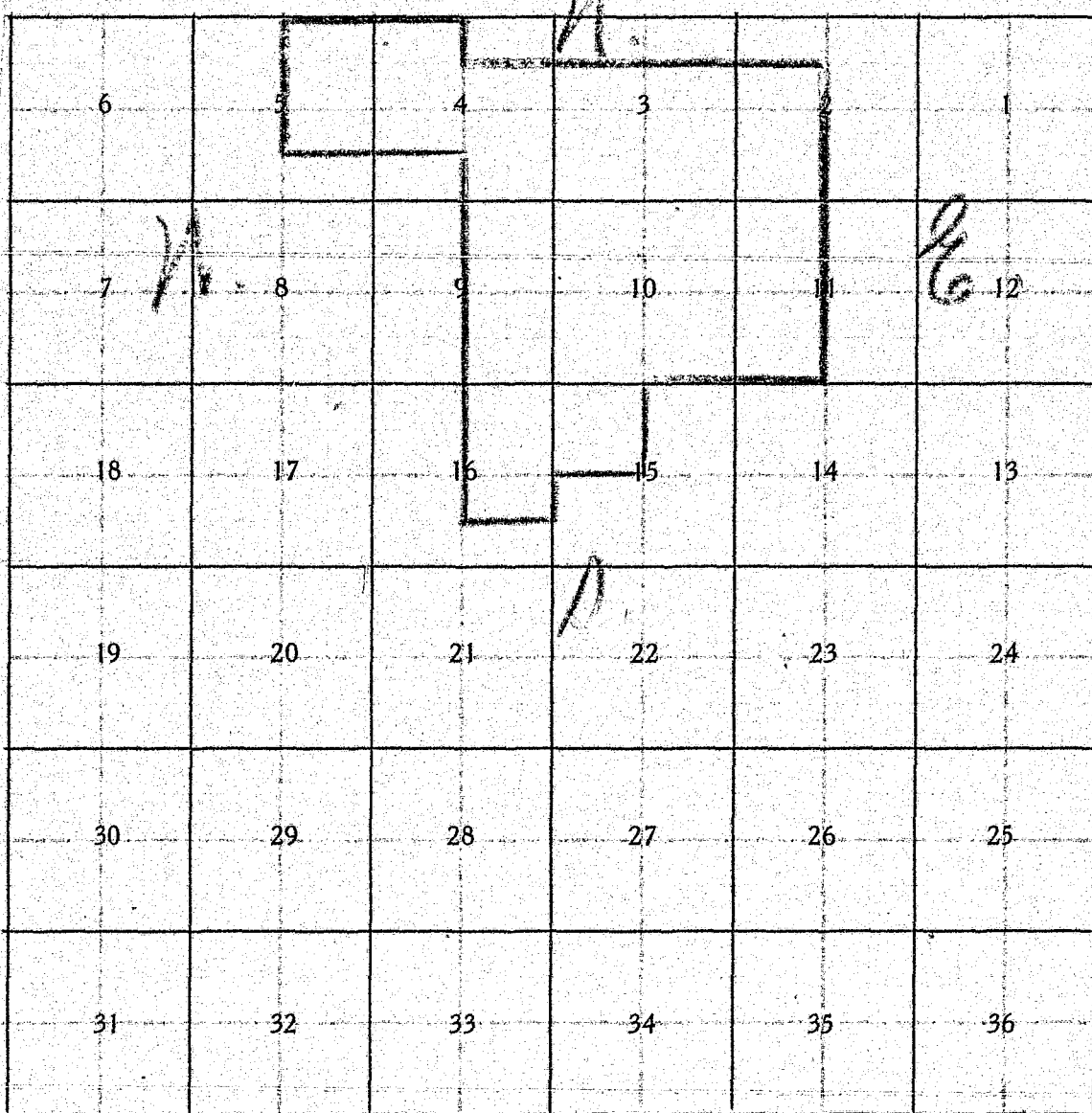
