PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, MINNESOTA, the Land of 10,000 Lakes, is soon to play host to the WOMAN'S INTERNATIONAL BOWLING CONGRESS and to the AMERICAN BOWLING CONGRESS, which will hold their Annual Championship Tournaments here in 1964 and 1965, respectively; and

WHEREAS, bowling has developed into one of the leading sports in the United States and in this State and more men, women, and children participate in bowling than in any other competitive sport; and

WHEREAS, bowling provides wholesome recreational activity on a year-round basis for all members of the family; and

WHEREAS, bowling has been playing an increasingly important role in community and school programs for our youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 6 through October 12, 1963, as

"BOWLING WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge the appropriate observance of this occasion.
