

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the day of October 7, 1963, is being observed nationally as Child Health Day; and
WHEREAS, the children of today are the adults of tomorrow; and
WHEREAS, more children's deaths are caused by accidents than from diphtheria, influenza, measles, pneumonia, and tuberculosis combined; and
WHEREAS, individuals with safe habits and safe equipment can prevent accidental injury to themselves and to others;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 7, 1963, as

"CHILD HEALTH DAY"

and I encourage all agencies and individuals to correct existing or potential accident hazards in their homes and elsewhere in order that children may be safeguarded.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
