P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the provision of educational opportunity in our state is an eternal debt of this generation to the next; and

WHEREAS, education is an essential basis for America's freedom, security, and prosperity; and

WHEREAS, education is confronted by unparalleled problems - such as shortages in teacher supply, classrooms, and finance - which can be solved only by public understanding and public actions; and

WHEREAS, a rapidly changing world requires that education change to meet new challenges without diminishing the traditional American appreciation of the worth of the individual, the obligations of responsible citizenship, the dignity of constructive employment, and the value of the basic moral and spiritual values;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate November 10 - 16, 1963 to be

"AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK"

and urge all citizens to acquaint themselves more fully with the programs and needs of education and to rededicate themselves to strengthening and improving this essential safeguard of our nation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
