Dear Governor Rolvang:

By way of explanation as to the latter of Judge Erickson which is enclosed, the Judge suffered a heart attack on the evening of September 3, 1903. He is now at the union Hospital in New Ulm.

The morning of September 3, 1963, he informed me that he was going to submit his retirement letter to you and that he wanted to complete 10 years of mervice. My purpose in writing this letter is to insure that there is no sisunder-standing as to the 10 years. I understand that he was appointed to his office on October 1, 1951, to take office lotaber 2, 1951. By making his resignation effective October 2, 1903, I believe, he will have completed 12 years.

Mrs. Erickson asked me to prepare his letter of resignation, which I did, and in view of my conversation with the Judge I just want to be sure I leave no room for doubt as to his wish to complete 12 years of service.

Dear Covernor Rolvags:

Under and pursuant to Chapter 739 of the Minnesota Session Laws of 1963, and in conformity therewith, I, Thorse D. Erickson, of the age of 77 years, and one of the District Judges of the Fifth Judicial District of Minnesota, and having served as such District Judge continuously since October 2, 1951, do hereby make application to you, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, for retirement as such District Judge effective as of October 2, 1963.

I was re-elected in the November election, 1958, and my present term ends on January 1, 1965.

I understand that as of the date of my ratirement on October 2, 1963, I will be entitled to a renaion under the law cited above of 12/15ths (which is 4/5ths) of \$9,250.00 per year.

I also understand that I waive receiving my full salary for the remaining portion of my elected term as I am electing to receive the pension my 12 years of service entitles me to.

If any further information is necessary will you kindly advise me.
