ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING  
THE DATE OF THE REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION  
PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES SECTION 205.07

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEWPORT ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the regular Village election shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect for all Village elections occurring after January 1, 1964 and after its publication according to law.
