PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, On the evening of Wednesday, September 13th, 1916, in the County of Itasca in the State of Minnesota, Olga Dahl was the victim of a most brutal assault and

WHEREAS, The assailant of the said Olga Dahl has not been apprehended and the public welfare requires his capture, conviction and punishment for said offense,

NOW. THEREFORE. I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State the sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250) for the arrest and conviction or for information leading to the arrest and conviction of said assailant.
