KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WALTER F. MONDALE, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 8.06, Minnesota Statutes, 1961, have constituted and appointed

MILTON H. ALTMAN

of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General on October 22, 1963, for the purpose of representing the University of Minnesota in matters directed to him by myself or by Mr. Lunden, Vice-President of the University of Minnesota. He shall be compensated in a reasonable fee basis, which shall include all clerical and other necessary office expenses incurred by counsel, together with necessary travel expenses; and that said compensation is to be paid from the funds of the University of Minnesota upon verified claims therefor presented to said University by the appointee. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.
