ORDINANCE NO. 1222 AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rachester, Minnesota, Certain Umplatted Land Not Exceeding Two Hundred Across In Area, All Being in a Part of the Southwest One-Quarter of Section Twenty-Three, Township One Hundred Seven Narth, Range Fourteen West, Olmsted County, Minnesota. Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by all the owners of the land described Therein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester, The land de-scribed in Olmsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows: The East 250,00 feet of the North 52,72 feet of the West 600.00 feet of the South 871.33 feet of Section Twenty-there (23), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Fourfeen (14) West, Olmsted County, Minnesota. Sid petition has also been filed with the Town Board of the Township of Cascade, with the County Board of the County of Olmsted, and with the Mu-nicipal Commission of the State of Minne-sota, and more than thirty (30) days have elapsed since said petition was filed with said Town Board and County Board and no objections to annexation of the tabove described land have been filed by said Town Board or County Board. Section 2. The Quantity of unplatted land included in said petition is 3.0 acres, more or less. Section 3. The Common Council of the City of Rochester does hereby defermine that the lands described in Section 1 abut upon the present territorial limits of the City of Rochester are so conditioned as to be properly subjected to Municipal Government, and the annexation of said lands will be in the basi inferests of the City of Rochester are so conditioned as to be properly subjected to Municipal Government, and the annexation of the lands affected. Section 1. Therefore, the lands described in added to and made a part of the City

Government, and the annexation of said lands will be in the best interests of the City of Rochester and of the lands affected. Section 4. Therefore, the lands described in Section 1 above are hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the City of Rochester, Minnesota, as effectually as if they had originally been a part thereof. Section 5. Present and future owners of the area annexed by this Ordinance are hereby notified that in addition to the usual assessments, it is the infention of the Common Council to assess against benefited property all or a portion of the cost of any storm sewer, water tower and trunk line sanitary sewer con-struction, hereforce or hereafter, under-taken to serve the area annexed. Section 6. Present and future owners of the area annexed by this Ordinance are hereby notified that by such annexa-tion, the City of Rochester does not com-mit itself to extend its services and make local improvements in the area annexed on an assessment basis: and that the City of Rochester, through its Common Council, specifically reserves the right to annex additional areas to the City of Rochester and extend City services, and make local improvements to such other later annexed areas in advance of im-provements to the area hereby annexed it the same appears more reasonable and economical. Section 7. This ordinance is a re-enactment of Ordinance No. 1209 and shall take effect and be in force from after its official publication and from and after the filling of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commis-sion, the Counly Auditor and the Secre-tary of State.
