I, KARL F. ROLVAAG, Governor of the State of Minnesota  
do hereby order and declare that:

1. The public policy of Minnesota prohibits discrimination  
against any of its inhabitants on account of race, creed, color  
or national origin.

2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1961, § 181.59, every  
contract for or on behalf of the State of Minnesota or any of its  
subdivisions, for materials, supplies or construction, may be  
cancelled or terminated by the state or any of its subdivisions  
when discrimination on account of race, creed or color exists  
in the hiring or employment of common or skilled labor by the  
contractor, sub-contractor, material supplier, or vendor,  
performing work pursuant to a contract for or on behalf of the  
State of Minnesota or any of its subdivisions.

3. Upon complaint that discrimination exists in any contract  
for or on behalf of the State, the Commissioner of Administration  
shall investigate and, when necessary, he or his designee shall  
conduct a hearing to take such evidence as may be necessary to  
determine whether or not discrimination in fact exists.

4. If the Commissioner determines that discrimination by  
any contractor, sub-contractor, material supplier or vendor  
exists, he may suspend, cancel or terminate the contract.

5. If a second or subsequent act of discrimination is  
found to exist, the Commissioner may, in addition to suspending,  
cancelling, or terminating such contract, declare all money  
due or to become due pursuant to such contract, forfeited to  
the State of Minnesota.
