WHEREAS, our youth, by becoming more active in affairs which concern all of our citizens, will become better leaders in our next generations; and

WHEREAS, the Optimists Clubs throughout the world have selected the week of November 11 - 17, 1963, to be set aside to honor the youth of our communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvaaq, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 11 - 17, 1963, as
