ORDINANCE NO. 355

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

That part of Lot Seven (7) of Auditor's Sublots 1 to 12, in the South One-Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 24, Township 102 North, Range 40 West, Nobles County, Minnesota, described as:
Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Lot 7, thence North along the East line thereof, a distance of 110 feet, thence West at right angles 139.25 feet, thence South and parallel to the East line of said Lot 7, a distance of 110 feet, thence East on the South line of said Lot 7, a distance of 139.25 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described is thirty-five one hundredths (.35) acres.

Section 3. A hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Corporation, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.

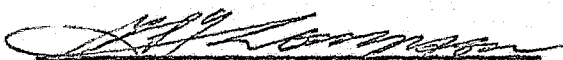

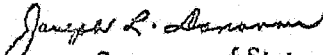
