ORDINANCE NUMBER 535

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ANNEXATION
OF LUM PARK TO THE
CITY OF BRAINERD


The City Council of the City of Brainerd do ordain:

Section 1. That the City of Brainerd owns Lots Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7) of Auditor's Subdivision of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty (20) in Township Forty-five (45) North of Range Thirty (30) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, which comprises Lum Park.




Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after one week after its publication.


