PROCLAMATION



- WHEREAS, Accidents are caused by acts of carelessness or inexperience which may endanger others and constitute a failure of each individual to assume his moral responsibilities for his fellowman, and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota clergymen of all faiths under the guidance of the Religious Leaders Section of the Minnesota Baptist Council have joined in an effort to make every person aware of his moral responsibilities for his fellow citizen, and
- WHEREAS, It is imperative that every Minnesotan join in this united religious effort to awaken in the conscience and mind of every person the realization that carelessness, recklessness, and negligence endangering the lives of others may be a transgression of God's command, "Thou shalt not kill."


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of December 15 through January 1, 1964, as

"HOLIDAY SAFETY SEASON"

and urge every Minnesotan to practice the Golden Rule of "doing unto others as you would have them do unto you" not only during this HOLIDAY SAFETY SEASON, but at all times during the year hereafter.
