## DRUMBACK NO BIO

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF STILLWATER

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following described tracts, pieces or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Washington, State of Minnesota, and abutting upon the City of Stillwater, said City of Stillwater being the owner thereof, are hereby declared to be annexed to said City, towit:

The North Fifty (50) feet of that part of the North Half of the Northwest Quarter (N½ of NW1) lying East of the public road, as now laid out and established in Section Thirty-two (32), in Township Thirty (30) North, of Range Twenty (20) West of the Fourth Meridian, containing .067 acres, more or less, according to the United States Government Survey thereof, and

All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NWA) of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of Section Thirty-two (32) in Township Thirty (30) North of Range Twenty (20) West of the Fourth Meridian, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of said tract and running thence Easterly along the North line thereof, a distance of One Hundred Minety-one (191) feet, more or less, to a point opposite the Southwest Corner of Block Twenty-five (25) of McKinstry and Seeleys Second Addition to Stillwater, Minnesota; thence Southorly parallel with the West line of said tract to a point One Hundred (100) feet South of the Worth line of said tract; thence Easterly parallel with the South line of said Block Twenty-five (25) Fifty (50) feet; thence Southerly parallel with the West line of said tract One Hundred Thirty (130) feet; thence Westerly parallel with the South line of Blocks Twenty-five (25) and Twenty-six (26) of McKinstry and Seeleys Second Addition One Hundred Thirty (130) feet; thence Northerly parallel with the West line of said tract One Hundred Winety (190) feet; thence Westerly parallel with the South line of Block Twenty-six (26) of McKinstry and Seeleys Second Addition One Hundred Eleven (111) feet, more or less, to the West line of said tract; thence Northerly along said West line of said tract Fifty (50) feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing approximately 0.6937 acre, according to the United States Covernment Survey thereof; excepting and reserving unto Gilbert J. Benson and Lydia B. Benson, husband and wife, their heirs and assigns, a perpetual right of way and easement over and across the North Fifty (50) feet of said property for the purposes of ingress and egress to and from the so-called "St. Paul Road".

section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law and upon filing a copy of the ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Auditor of Washington County, and the Secretary of State. Thereupon such territory shall become a part of the City of Stillwater as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.
