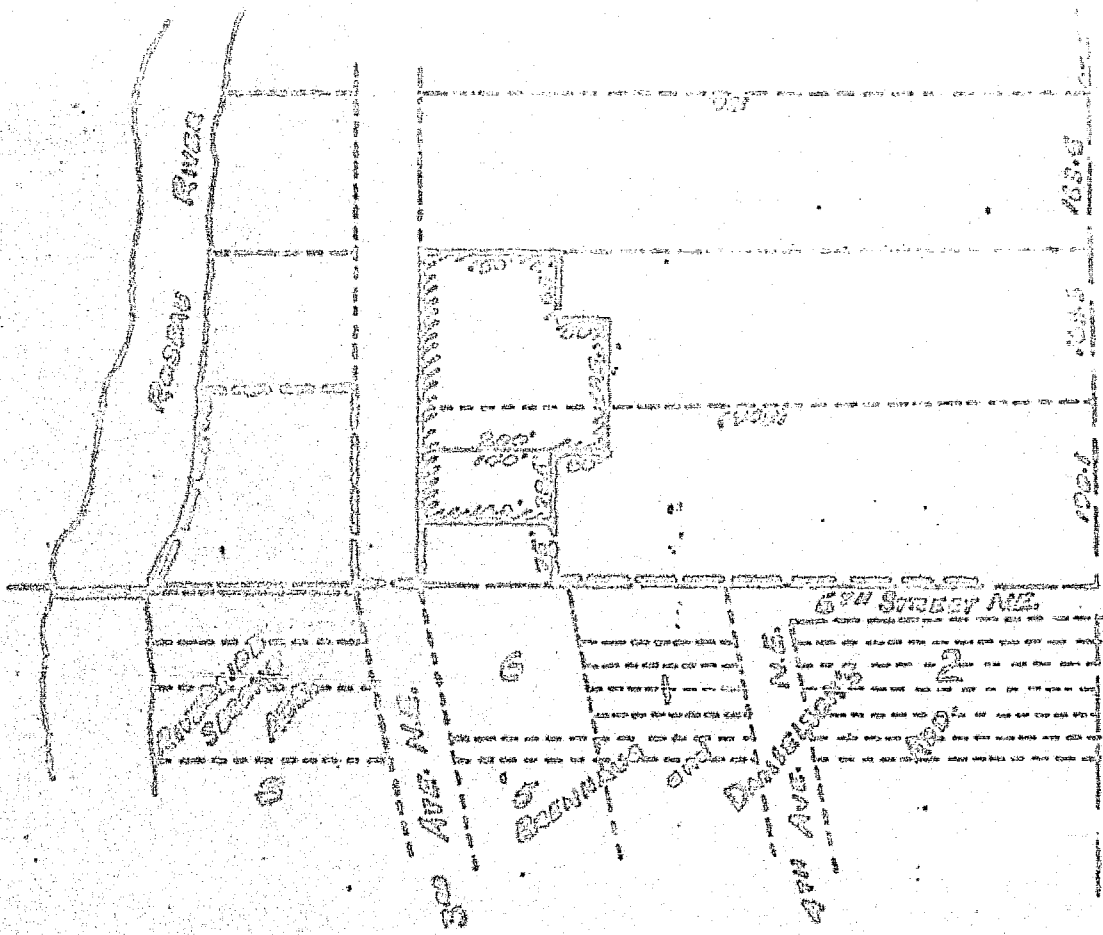

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Roseau, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described land, situated, lying and being in the County of Roseau, and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Commencing at a point in the Easterly line of the Public Highway extending Northerly and Southerly through said Riverside Subdivision "E", which Public Highway is commonly referred to as Riverside Avenue but is not officially designated as such, a distance of 75 feet North of the South line of said Riverside Subdivision "E", thence Northerly on and along said East line of said Public Highway to a point where a line drawn East and West through the Center of Subdivision "D" of said Riverside Subdivision would intersect with the East line of said Public Highway; thence due East 150 feet; thence at right angles due South 65 feet; thence at right angles due East 50 feet; thence Southerly parallel with the East line of said Public Highway 135 feet; thence at right angles due West 60 feet; thence Southerly and parallel with the East line of said Riverside Avenue to a point 75 feet North of the South line of said Riverside Subdivision "E"; thence West, parallel with said South line of said Riverside Subdivision "E" a distance of 140 feet to the point of beginning; according to the recorded plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Roseau County, Minnesota, said land containing less than 200 acres,

abutting upon the incorporated Village of Roseau, Minnesota, be and the same hereby is annexed to said Village, to become a part of said Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance is passed pursuant to a petition signed by all the owners of the above described real estate.

Section 3. That said real estate is so conditioned as to be subject to municipal government, and that annexation thereof will be for the best interests of said Village and said real estate.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, and filing a copy thereof with the Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of Minnesota.
