of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Public Welfare and fix his compensation in the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500) Dollars per year, to be paid from and out of the funds of said department. Said JAMES H. GAFFNEY shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 17th day of October, 1963.


