Ordinance No. 50 .

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF RAY-MOND, AND DECLARING SAME TO BE AN ADDITION TO SAID VILLAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF RAYMOND AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A petition has been filed with the Village Council of the Village of Raymond, Minnesota, by the owners of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the Village of Raymond, Minnesota, as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West Line of the Southeast Quarter (SE%) of Section Nineteen (19), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Thirty-Six (36) 660 feet South of the Northwest corner of said quarter section; thence East 10 rods parallel with the North line of said quarter section; thence South 122 feet parallel with the West boundary line of said quarter section; thence West 10 rods parallel with the North boundary line of said section; thence North 122 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. The land embraced in the foregoing description is unplatted land.

SECTION 3. The Village Council makes the following determination, to-wit:

- That the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Raymond, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
- 2) That the territory described herein abuts upon and is adjacent to the Village of Raymond, Minnesota and is so conditioned as properly to be subject to the government of said Village.

SECTION 4. Therefore, the Village of Raymond, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property herein before described by, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Raymond, Minnesota.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in full force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Kandiyohi County and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 6. Two copies of the Petition for Annexation have been filed with the County Board of Kandiyohi County, two copies of the Petition have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission and two copies of the Petition have been filed with the Town Board of the Township of Edwards and that no written objection to the annexation have been received within 30 days of the filing of said Petition.
