AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FAIRMONT, MINNESOTA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRMONT, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a petition presented to the City Council of the City of Fairmont, Minnesota, requesting that property hereinafter described be annexed to the City of Fairmont has been signed by Richard Kunard and Ida Kunard, the owners of said property; that the said property abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Fairmont, Minnesota; that it is so conditioned to be properly subject to municipal government; that the unplatted part thereof does not exceed two hundred (200) acres in area; that the annexation will be to the best interest of the municipality and the territory affected; that said petition is in accordance with M. S. A., Section 414.03 and is in all things sufficient; that said petition has been on file with the Martin County Board of Commissioners, the Town Board of Fairmont Township, and the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota for a period of not less than 30 days in accordance with Law and that no written objections to said petitions have been submitted.

Section 2. That the property set forth in said petition is located in the County of Martin, State of Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

A part of Government Lot Three (3), in Section Eighteen (18), of Township One Hundred Two (102) North of Range Thirty (30) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 1213 Feet East from the center of said Section Eighteen (18) on the East boundary line of State Aid Road No. 72, running thence South  $6^{\circ} 18'$  along the said road boundary line a distance of one hundred (100) feet, running thence East and parallel with the East and West Center Line of said Section Eighteen (18) a distance of two hundred six (206) feet, more or less, to the shore line of Budd Lake, running thence Northwesterly and following the shore line of Budd Lake a distance of one hundred (100) feet, more or less, to the East and West center line of said Section Eighteen (18), running thence West on said center line a distance of two hundred six (206) feet more or less to the place of beginning;


and that the said property be, and the same hereby is, extended to and incorporated within the corporate limits of the City of Fairmont, Minnesota, and is hereby
