

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the citizens of Minnesota and countless others throughout the Nation are daily confronted by the enemy known as Heart Disease, and
- WHEREAS, last year, 1963, approximately 15,000 lives in Minnesota were claimed by this dreaded scourge, and
- WHEREAS, this terrible toll will doubtless occur again this year and in the years to come unless every responsible citizen joins in the crusade to fight and overcome this enemy of all the people, and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Heart Association, a unit of the American Heart Association is seeking, through its volunteers to gather and provide funds for medical research to help control and stop Heart Disease,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Roelvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1964, as

"HEART FUND MONTH"

in Minnesota, and Sunday, February 23, 1964, as "HEART SUNDAY." I urge each Minnesotan to answer the appeal to help defeat Heart Disease by contributing generously to the Heart Fund when called upon by a neighborhood Heart Sunday Volunteer.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four and of the State the one hundred seventh.
