

PROCLAMATION


WHEREAS, the citizens of Minnesota and countless others throughout the nation are daily confronted by the enemy known as Heart Disease, and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1964, as
