

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, the history of America reveals the problems, struggles and accomplishments which the people of our country have made, and

- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Daughters of the American Revolution are urging greater attention to and emphasis upon American history,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Colvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February, 1964, as


"AMERICAN HISTORY MONTH"
