P R O C L A M A T I O N

- WHEREAS, in spite of the efforts by individual citizens to use caution and care, the number who die and many who are injured through accidents and illness each year steadily increases, and
- WHEREAS, there are hazards in the home and on the highways that lie beyond the conscious control of the individual, even beyond his human intent and awareness of moral responsibility, and
- WHEREAS, it is fitting that we set aside a period of time to focus public attention on the necessity of protection against accident and sickness, emphasizing the importance of a reverence for life, one's own as well as the lives of others,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvas, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 1964, as

"ACCIDENT AND HEALTH PROTECTION MONTH"

In Minnesota in recognition of the insurance industry and its vital contributions to the protection of human life, health and property.
