

ORDINANCE NO. 377

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE TO
INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND NOT EX-
CEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, by a majority of all of the owners in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota:

Ramsley's Park, Blocks 16, 17, 23 and 24,
also subj. to widened STH 96 and ex S 3 acres;
the W 165' of NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 23,
T 30, R 22.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is less than two hundred (200) acres.

Section 3. A hearing was duly held by the governing body of the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after at least thirty (30) days posted notice.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 5. Therefore, the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described by and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.
