

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota by the sole owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota:

Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), and Ten (10) of Block One (1), Cottage Park, according to the plot thereof on file and of record in the office of the Registrar of Deeds in and for the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota.

Section 2. The quantity of lands embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described, is less than 200 acres.

Section 3. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to City government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a Certified Copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
