IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION AND APPLICATION OF THE CITY OF MORRIS, COUNTY OF SHERBURN, STATE OF MINNESOTA, PETITIONER FOR AN ORDER OF DETACHMENT AS AUTHORIZED BY LAWS 1963 CHAPTERS 207 AND 211

ORDER

The City of Morris has, by resolution at a meeting of the City Council held on the 15th day of September, 1963, petitioned for the detachment of certain property adjacent to the City boundary, unplatted, occupied and used exclusively for agricultural purposes, hereinafter described, from the City of Morris, Minnesota. An identical petition has been received from all of the owners of the property affected:

The territory involved consists of:

The South and Half of the Northeast Quarter (3600) of Section Four (4) Township Two Hundred Twenty Four (244), North, Range Forty Two West (42W).

The property is unplatted, occupied and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The detachment would not unreasonably affect the economy of the municipality. The land is not needed for reasonably anticipated future development. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Laws 1963, Chapter, 414, Minnesota Statutes 1961 as amended by Laws 1963 Chapters 207 and 211 and upon all the filers and records, the Municipal Commission being duly advised in the premises.

IT IS ORDERED That the foregoing described real property be, and is hereby, detached from the City of Morris and set aside.
