ORDINANCE NO. 18.01

An Ordinance Extending The Corporate Limits of The Village of Annandale To Include Unplatted Lands Not To Exceed Two Hundred Acres.

The Village Council of Annandale, Minnesota, do ordain:

Section 1. A Petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Annandale by the sole owner of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Annandale, Minnesota.

The East One-half or the Southwest Quarter, except the railway and highway, and the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, south of the railway, all in Section 29, Township 121 North, Range 27 West.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 114.92 acres.

Section 3. Copies of the petition have been duly filed, on the 29th day of October, 1963, with Milton Ransom, Clerk of Corinna Town Board of Supervisors, and Dave Douglas, Clerk of Wright County Board of Commissioners; fees required by the Minnesota Municipal Commission have been paid; and more than thirty days have elapsed and no objections have been received, either by the Village of Annandale or the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 4. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Annandale, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is urban in character and is so conditioned as property to be subject to Village Government.

Section 5. The Village of Annandale, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Annandale, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof; and, in accordance with Chapter 807, Laws of 1963, copies hereof be filed with the Municipal Commission, County Auditor and Secretary of State.
