
Gentlemen:

ORDINANCE NO. 240

VILLAGE OF ADRIAN, NOBLES COUNTY, MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF ADRIAN

WHEREAS, The tract of land hereinafter described is owned by the Village of Adrian, is urban in character, abuts on the Village of Adrian, and is not included in any other municipality,

AND WHEREAS, The annexation of such tract of land hereinafter described is authorized under the above circumstances pursuant to Minn. Stats. 1961, Sec. 414.03, Subd. 2,

Be it ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Adrian as follows:

Section 1. The following described tract of land is hereby annexed to the Village of Adrian:

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24, Township 102, Range 43, described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Meyer's Addition to the Village of Adrian, thence Southerly and parallel to the East section line of said Section 24, a distance of 33 feet, thence Easterly and parallel with the South line of the said Meyer's Addition to the East section line of said Section 24, thence Northerly and parallel with the East section line of said Section 24, a distance of 33 feet, thence Westerly along the South line of the said Meyer's Addition in a direct line to the place of beginning.

Section 2. This order shall be effective upon its passage and publication, and upon filing a copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Auditor of Nobles County, and the Minnesota Secretary of State.
