ORDINANCE NO. 257

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF HUTCHINSON, McLEOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The City Council of the City of Hutchinson ordains:

SECTION I.

WHEREAS, Harold J. Schmidt and Josephine B. Schmidt are the owners of the following described lands lying and being in the County of McLeod and State of Minnesota and described as follows, to-wit:

The East 200 feet of Lot Four of the Auditor's Plat of that part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 116 North, Range 30 West, lying South of the Mill Pond, according to the plat on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for McLeod County, Minnesota.

WHEREAS, Donald Dobratz and Irene Dobratz are the owners of the following described lands lying and being in the County of McLeod and State of Minnesota and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 3 of the Auditor's Plat of that Part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 116 North, Range 30 West, lying South of the Mill Pond, according to the plat on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for McLeod County, Minnesota, except the East 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet thereof.

SECTION II.

AND WHEREAS, said above described lands are completely surrounded by land within the Municipal Limits of the City of Hutchinson and are so conditioned as properly to be subject to municipal government.

SECTION III:

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hutchinson deems it desirable and in the best interest of the City of Hutchinson to annex the above described lands to the City of Hutchinson.

SECTION IV.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hutchinson that the lands described above be and they hereby are annexed to the City of Hutchinson and from and after the date of passage of this Ordinance, said lands shall become a part and portion of the City of Hutchinson with the same force and effect as though originally a part of the City.

SECTION V.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
