BE IT OMPAINED, By the Villege Council of the Villege of Dilvorth, on follows:

Section 1. That Peter Houge and Hergit Houge, his wife, are the record owners in fee simple of the real estate hereinafter described and Raymond Welle and Dorothy Welle, his wife; and Gorman R. Sampson and Rathleen R.
