



ORDINANCE NO. 299

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
PROPERTY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF
NORTH TO THE CITY OF THIEF
RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls
do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1: It is hereby determined that the
annexation of the property hereinafter described will
be to the best interest of the City of Thief River
Falls and the territory affected.

Section 2: The Petition of Petitioners is hereby
granted and the following described property is hereby
declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls:

Real estate situated in the County of Pennington
and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of Government
Lot Four (4) in Section Twenty-seven (27), in
Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154), North, of
Range Forty-three (43) in Pennington County,
Minnesota, lying east of the following described
line, hereinafter referred to as line "A" to-wit:
Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot One (1)
Block Three (3) of Riverside Addition to Thief
River Falls, Minnesota, thence North no degrees
and forty-eight (48) minutes west five hundred and
sixty-four and $50/100$ (564.50) feet; thence North
eleven degrees, thirty-five minutes ($11^{\circ} 35'$) West,
one hundred and two (102) feet to the East and West
sixteenth ($1/16$ th) section line forming the North
boundary line of said government lot Four (4), saving
and excepting therefrom any and all streets, roads,
and public highways, flowage rights of record, and
also excepting the following described parcels of
land, to-wit:

(1) Beginning at a point on the South boundary line of
the North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of said Government Lot Four (4)
sixty (60) feet East of said line "A", thence
running along said boundary line two hundred and
ninety-five (295) feet to a point; thence North
and parallel to said line "A" two hundred and ninety-
five (295) feet; thence west and parallel to said
south boundary line two hundred and ninety-five (295)

feet, more or less, to a point sixty (60) feet east of said line "A"; thence South and parallel to said line "A" two hundred and ninety-five (295) feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

(2)

All that certain tract of land lying in and being a part of Section Twenty-seven (27) in Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154) North of Range Forty-three (43) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as follows:

Commencing for a point of beginning at a point which is the point of intersection of the East line of Reserve Avenue and the North line of Riverside Addition to Thief River Falls; thence running Easterly upon said North line of Riverside Addition a distance of one hundred twenty (120) feet; thence North one hundred fifty (150) feet; thence East parallel to and one hundred fifty (150) feet Northerly of the said North line of Riverside Addition to the West bank of Thief River; thence Southeasterly upon the said bank of Thief River to the intersection of the said river bank and the said North line of Riverside Addition; thence West along and upon the said North line of Riverside Addition to the point of beginning.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication and upon filing a copy of this Ordinance with the State of Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Pennington County and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
