

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12

EXECUTIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING THE STATE COMMISSION FOR HIGHER EDUCATION
FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Higher Education Facilities Act of 1963 (H.R. 6143) enacted by the eighty-eighth Congress of the United States authorizes financial assistance to institutions of higher education for the construction, rehabilitation or improvement of needed higher education facilities; and

WHEREAS, said Act provides for a program of grants to public as well as private higher education institutions; and

WHEREAS, said Act requires that in order for a state to become eligible to receive grants, an agency must be designated to carry out the provisions of the Act, which agency is required to be "broadly representative of the public and of institutions of higher education (including junior colleges and technical institutes) in the state;"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby establish the State Commission for Higher Education Facilities, to be composed of the following named persons: Dr. Sidney A. Rand, Northfield, President of St. Olaf College; Mrs. Marian B. Clauzon, Northfield, Member of the State College Board; Mr. Robert E. Hess, White Bear Lake, Member of the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota; Mr. Eino Syring, Hibbing, Member of the State Junior College Board; and John E. Carroll, St. Paul, Minnesota. Further, said Commission is hereby designated as the agency which will carry out the responsibilities of implementing the Higher Education Facilities Act of 1963 as that Act pertains to institutions in Minnesota.
