AN ORDINANCE EXTENDED THE CONFEMATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF VOTENINGTON, INDEDUCA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN TUPLATIES LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordein:

Section 1. A potition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the emers in number of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

A tract of law in the Southwest (warter (SM)) of Section 13, Tomohip 102 North, Range 40 West, in the County of Nobles and State of Missesota, described as follows to-wit,

Deginning at a point on the West line of the Southwest Quarter (SWZ) of Section 13, Township 102 North, Renge hO West, 937 feet North of the Southwest corner thereof; thence continuing North CO degrees CO minutes East a distance of 150 feet; thence South C9 degrees 27 nimutes East for hCO feet; thence South CO degrees CO minutes a distance of 150 feet; thence South C9 degrees 27 minutes Nest hCO feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.56 acres more or less.
