ORDINANCE NO. 309

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN  
PROPERTY ABUTTING THE CITY OF  
ANOKA, TO THE CITY OF ANOKA

The City Commission of the City of  
Anoka do ordain:

Section 1. Pursuant to a proper and  
sufficient petition by the owner of a  
tract, piece and parcel of land abut-  
ting the City of Anoka, Minnesota,  
and described as follows, to-wit:

Lots Six (6), Seven (7), and Ten  
(10), of Auditor's Subdivision Num-  
ber 28, Anoka County, Minnesota,  
according to the map or plat there-  
of on file and of record in the office  
of the Register of Deeds in and  
for said county and state,

to have said property annexed to the  
City of Anoka, said tract, piece and  
parcel of land is hereby declared an  
addition to the City of Anoka.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be  
in force and effect after its passage  
and publication according to law.




