ORDINANCE NO. 328

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY ABUTTING THE CITY OF ANOKA, TO THE CITY OF ANOKA.

The City Commission of the City of Anoka do ordain:

Section 1. Pursuant to a proper and sufficient petition by the owner of a tract, piece and parcel of land abutting the City of Anoka, Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

The South forty (40) acres of the North fifty-five (55) acres of the North half of the Southeast Quarter (N½ of SE¼) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Thirty-two (32), Range Twenty-four (24), according to the map or plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Anoka County, Minnesota.

to have said property annexed to the City of Anoka, said tract, piece and parcel of land is hereby declared an addition to the City of Anoka.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.
