PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, More than 15,000 Americans will die this year from Leukemia, a disease which is 100 per cent fatal, and

WHEREAS, The welfare, security and future of our community and of the nation depends upon the welfare and security of its individual citizens, and

WHEREAS, Leukemia Society, Incorporated is seeking funds for its constant battle against the disease through research, patient aid and public education, and the purposes, aims and energies of this campaign are deserving of the support of every citizen, and

WHEREAS, The Fourth Annual Leukemia Drive will take place in this State from March 1 through March 31, 1964,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvason, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 1 through March 31, 1964, as

"LEUKEMIA MONTH"

In Minnesota and urge that all citizens give full support to this campaign to help end the ravages of Leukemia.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-seventh day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four and of the State the one hundred sixth.
