PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The likelihood of a nuclear attack remains a real threat which imperils the lives and property of our citizens, and

WHEREAS, The ability of this nation to respond to an enemy attack is dependent upon the ability of each individual citizen, and each level of Government to competently carry out its emergency responsibility, and

WHEREAS, The ability of individuals and governments to respond to an emergency is dependent upon prior planning based on accurate information, and

WHEREAS, The Minnesota State Department of Education in cooperation with local school districts is conducting a program to make the accurate information needed for planning to meet a major disaster available to everyone through a 12-hour course called Survival Preparedness.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1964, as

"GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES' MONTH"

and call upon all elected and appointed officials and employees to participate in this urgently-needed program.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-sixth day of March, in the Year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four and of the State, the one hundred sixth.
