WHEREAS, the Submarine Veterans of World War II are striving to further promote and keep alive the spirit and unity that existed between submarine crewmen during World War II, and

WHEREAS, the defense of our country depends in great measure on the patriotic dedication and technical skill of those who serve United States Navy in its submarines, and

WHEREAS, all Minnesotans are intensely proud of the fifty-two members of the Submarine Veterans of World War II who are fostering the ideals of this fine branch of military service,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Holmberg, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning April 11 through April 18, 1964, as

"SUBMARINE VETERANS WEEK"

in Minnesota, and invite the attention of all our citizens to this observance.
