WHEREAS, The natural landscape of Minnesota, as well as its rural and urban communities, must be guarded against sojlement through a continuing campaign of public awareness of the unsightly and unhealthy effects of debris and litter, and

WHEREAS, The Federated Garden Clubs of Minnesota, affiliated with the National Council of State Garden Clubs, is working diligently to instill an awareness of the advantages and the necessity of keeping Minnesota beautiful this week and in all the weeks to come;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl P. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim this week of April 15-21, 1964, as

"KEEP MINNESOTA BEAUTIFUL WEEK"

and I urge all citizens to recognize their responsibility by exerting effort and care to help make and keep Minnesota beautiful now and in the future.
