- WHEREAS, The scenic beauty of Minnesota, its highways, wooded areas, lakes and hills are a source of pleasure to all and our citizens are justly proud of it, and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota's outstanding attraction for visitors and residents alike is the beauty and scenic grandeur with which we have been so richly endowed, and it is the duty and the responsibility of all citizens to preserve this precious heritage, and
- WHEREAS, The natural landscape of Minnesota, as well as its rural and urban communities, must be guarded against sootfallment through a continuing campaign of public awareness of the unsightly and unhealthy effects of debris and litter, and
- WHEREAS, The Federated Garden Clubs of Minnesota, affiliated with the National Council of State Garden Clubs, is working diligently to instill an awareness of the advantages and the necessity of keeping Minnesota beautiful this week and in all the weeks to come,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvåg, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 15-21, 1964, as

"KEEP MINNESOTA BEAUTIFUL WEEK"

and I urge all citizens to recognize their responsibility by exerting effort and care to help make and keep Minnesota beautiful now and in the future.
