P R O C L A M A T I O N


- WHEREAS, The President of the United States, by direction of an Act of Congress, has proclaimed April as Cancer Control Month, and

- WHEREAS, It is known that at least one out of every two cancer patients could be saved if more people saw their physicians for early detection, diagnosis and treatment, and
- WHEREAS, The continued efforts of medical scientists, physicians, dentists, public health workers, and volunteers depends on continued public support, encouragement and cooperation, and
- WHEREAS, To speed the final victory over cancer, the American Cancer Society must intensify its efforts to bring life-saving facts concerning cancer to the public, to improve the care of cancer patients and to accelerate its research program,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 1964, as
