PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Minnesota's outstanding attraction for visitors and its own citizens is the beauty and scenic grandeur with which it has been endowed, and

WHEREAS, It is the responsibility of all citizens to preserve this beauty, and

WHEREAS, The scenic beauty of our highways, wooded areas, lakes and hills are a source of pleasure to all, and these areas, as well as our urban communities, must be guarded by continued public awareness of the unsightly effect of debris and litter, and

WHEREAS, The campaign against litter has been aided by volunteer groups who are laying so valuable community improvement and beautification programs,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 19 through 25, 1964, as

"ANTI-LITTER AND ROADSIDE BEAUTIFICATION WEEK"

In Minnesota and urge all citizens to recognize their responsibilities for the success of these programs.
