PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Some six and a half million people in the United States now enjoy the healthful recreation and sportsmanship of the game of golf, and

WHEREAS, The Professional Golfers' Association of America will sponsor the thirteenth annual NATIONAL GOLF DAY on Saturday, May 30, 1964, and

WHEREAS, During the last twelve years, some \$950,000.00 has been realized from NATIONAL GOLF DAY for United Service Organizations, the American Red Cross, Caddie Scholarship Funds, the U.S. Blind Golfers' Association, the National Amputee Golf Association, the Jaycee War Memorial Fund, United Voluntary Services, American Women's Voluntary Services, the U.S. Olympic Association and other worthwhile projects, and

WHEREAS, This day in 1964 will offer all the golfers of America an opportunity to again assist many of these worthy charities and projects, as well as an opportunity to compete against the PGA Champion and the USGA Open Champion.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl P. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 30, 1964, as

"GOLF DAY"

IN Minnesota and urge all the golfers of our State to co-operate in this worthwhile venture by playing a round of golf on NATIONAL GOLF DAY, thereby contributing to the many deserving charities and projects associated with this great game.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four and of the State, the one hundred sixth.
