AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HENDRUM TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UMPLATTED LAND NOT EXCHEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a cortain petition dated February 25, 1964, requesting concention of the territory hereineffor described was duly presented to the council on the 2nd day of Merch, 1964; and

WHIREAS, the questity of land embraced within the area described in the polition and bounded as described is approximately 1.8125 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the ameration have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abute upon the village limits at the north boundary thereof;

The village council of Hendrum, Minnesota ordains: SECTION I. The Village council hereby determines:

- 1. That the emperation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory effected.
- 2. That the territory described herein abuts upon the village and is urban or suburban in character.
- 3. That none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION II. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

A parcel of land located within the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE1/45V1/4) in Section Mineteen (19), Township One Hundred Forty-four (144) North, of Range Forty-eight (46) West, of the Fifth Principal Meridian and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the

Northeast corner of Outlot 'Q" of the Village of Hendrum, Norman County, Minnesota, thence due East 240 feet, thence due South 990 feet to the South boundary line of said Section 19, thence due West 240 feet on the South boundary line of said Section 19, thence due North 380 feet on the East boundary line of said Outlot "Q" to the place of beginning.

SECTION III. Filling. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

SECTION IV. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filling of the cartified copies as directed in Section IV.
