P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the John Fitzgerald Kennedy Library will be erected in Boston as a memorial to President Kennedy, and  
WHEREAS, President Kennedy's idealism, his interest in youth, intellectualism, and education made him a friend on every campus, and  
WHEREAS, the Memorial will be a fitting tribute to the special contact that existed between President John F. Kennedy and students everywhere, and  
WHEREAS, when students heard about the plans for the Kennedy Library, they suggested a special student-given memorial within the Library, and  
WHEREAS, the National Student Committee of the John F. Kennedy Library has set May 4 through May 10, 1964, for a national student drive for support for the Kennedy Library, and  
WHEREAS, many schools and students in Minnesota are participating in the national drive,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 4 through May 10, 1964, as

"KENNEDY LIBRARY WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens, and students especially, to support the John F. Kennedy Memorial Library in commemoration of our late President.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of May in the year of our Lord the one thousand nine hundred sixteen-fourth and of the State, the one hundred sixth.
