Writ of election providing for filling the vacancy in the office of State Senator from the sixtieth senatorial district of the state at the general election on November 3, 1964, and providing for the nomination of candidates for said vacancy at the regular primary election to be held on September 8, 1964.

To the people of the State of Minnesota, and particularly of the sixtieth senatorial district of said state; To the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota; To the County Auditor of the County of St. Louis in said state; To all Election Officers in the sixtieth senatorial district, and of all of the several election districts therein; and To All Others whom it may concern:

WHEREAS a vacancy now exists in the office of State Senator from the sixtieth senatorial district of the State of Minnesota caused by the resignation of the Honorable Richard E. Ferrario; and

WHEREAS there will be occasion for the person elected to fill said vacancy to take office and to exercise the functions thereof at the next regular session of the state legislature;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KARL F. ROLVAAG, AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, acting under the authority and direction of Section 17 of Article IV of the Minnesota Constitution and the statutes in such case made and provided, do hereby direct that said vacancy be filled at the general election to be held in said district on November 3, 1964, and that candidates for said office be nominated at the regular primary election appointed by

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law to be held in said district on Tuesday, September 8, 1964; that affidavits of candidacy for nomination at said primary may be filed on and between the 10th day of June, 1964, and the 14th day of July, 5:00 P.M., 1964, both dates inclusive; that notices of said primary election and the said election thereafter be given, posted, and published as prescribed by law; and that the nomination and election of candidates and the conduct of said elections be had, and all things pertaining thereto be done, as provided in Minnesota Statutes, Sections 203.44 to 203.56, and other applicable provisions of law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of the State of Minnesota to be hereunto affixed at the Capitol in the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota, this $\underline{14}^{H}$ day of \underline{May} A.D., 1964.
